



Specific Objectives of the Long Term Management Plan:

- Identification of Modoc Line access points (trailheads)
- Identification of appropriate trail uses & location of uses (ie. motorized or non-motorized)
- Identification of signage needs
- Identification of needed railroad grade improvements (surface compaction, resurfacing, bridge repairs, road crossings, etc...)
- Identification of needed facility improvements (cattleguards, interpretive sites, etc...)
- Identification of routine maintenance needs
- Development of a Trail Plan implementation schedule

Proposed goals of the joint powers agreement include:

- Maintaining the corridor for a wide array of public uses including trail recreation, access to BLM lands for hunting, wildlife viewing and other appropriate activities as well as educational and interpretive opportunities. Maintenance of the corridor also provides the opportunity for potential future restoration of rail service.
- Conserving, monitoring, and enhancing the natural resources of the corridor and protecting the water quality of the area & surrounding watersheds.
- Limiting the impact to, and disturbance of, adjacent private lands.
- Encouraging responsible and sustainable use of adjacent public lands.
- Fostering a safe and inviting environment for the widest possible array of compatible user groups.
